	<b>Gift Fund, Winding Up and Revocation of DGR Status Policy</b>	<b>Date:</b> 15 April 2026 <b>Version:</b> 1.0

The Regional Circularity Co-operative Limited (RCC) sets out its policy on Gift Fund, Winding Up and Revocation of DGR Status as follows:

- that the RCC Board has authorised the establishment of a Gift Fund;
- the Gift Fund will be called the “RCC – Gift Fund”;
- that all monies received as gifts for the purposes of furthering the purposes and activities of the RCC will be deposited into the Gift Fund’s bank account;
- that those monies will be kept separate from any other monies of the RCC;
- that the Gift Fund will be dealt with in accordance with the requirements of the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission;
- that, in the event of the Gift Fund or the RCC being wound up or the DGR status being revoked, whichever first occurs, any surplus assets of the Gift Fund (after payment of liabilities attributable to it), will be transferred to another gift fund, authority or institution with similar charitable purposes and to which income tax-deductible gifts can be made.
